MOVING TO NEW SOUTH WALES

Sydney has a temperate climate with warm summers and mild winters. Climb the spectacular Harbour Bridge for a magnificent view of the city or soak up some sun at one of the 70 beaches in the urban area. Newcastle, reaching out to the sea and bounded by pristine beaches and an active working harbour, is the world's largest coal export port. The surf is world class, the pace remains relaxed and the friendly locals are proud of their city. It offers all the benefits and amenities of a large city but with all the friendliness of a regional town.

The NSW offices of URS are located in Artarmon and Newcastle. The Artarmon office is on the northern side of the famous Sydney Harbour Bridge and offers a close by shopping village offering a range of food outlets and various stores allowing easy browsing without the crowds of the Sydney CBD during the working week.
